

## 2 | APPROACH?

"Main Street" is a nationwide approach that works to revitalize historic downtowns. The National Trust for Historic Preservation created the holistic, preservation based economic development model in 1977 in reaction to economic decline and threats to traditional architecture in core commercial districts.

Our organization meets its goals by following the Main Street Four Point approach which includes design, organization, economic restructuring and promotion.

#### **OUR MISSION**

Laramie Main Street Alliance strives to preserve historic Downtown Laramie while enhancing its economic and social vitality.

#### **OUR TRANSFORMATION STRATEGY**

Develop Downtown as a home for entrepreneurs with a focus on authentic consumer experiences and creative Third Space.

## THE 4 POINTS Committees at Main Street

The Four Point approach helps communities get started with revitalization, and grows with them over time.





#### **ORGANIZATION**

The Organization Committee serves as Main Street's Human Resources arm, bringing resources, both people and funds, into the program.



#### **DESIGN**

The Design Committee works to make visual improvements to downtown through good design compatible with historic features.



#### **ECONOMIC VITALITY**

The Economic Restructuring Committee (in Laramie, this is our Downtown Development Authority) helps existing businesses expand, recruits new ones into the district, and revitalizes under utilized properties.



#### **PROMOTIONS**

The Promotions Committee is charged with enhancing the image & prospects of the downtown's unique social, economic, and cultural character through special events and marketing campaigns.



#### SO WHAT DOES ALL THIS MEAN?

Revitalization can take many forms and each of our committees, staff, volunteers, and partners work on different projects to make the transformation strategy come to life! Here are a few of our current projects.



#### PLACEMAKING DOWNTOWN

Laradise Lane, 1st Street Plaza, Parklet

Placemaking is a key focus in developing downtown as a destination for consumers. Since 2020, Laramie Main Street, with the help of the City of Laramie and other community partners, has implemented some new outdoor seating areas (Laradise Lane & a Parklet) and improved 1st Street plaza to enhance opportunities for retail and outdoor dining downtown.

Initially developed in Laramie as a creative Covid-19 strategy, outdoor spaces like these have long shown to have positive economic impacts, health and wellness benefits, as well as increased community building.

#### **SHOP LARAMIE**

#### Marketing efforts focused on shopping locally

Community support is how small businesses thrive! Throughout the pandemic it became clear to the Laramie community that they are the key to keeping their favorite businesses open and successful!

We at Laramie Main Street help support and nurture the shop small messaging in the community. Laramie Main Street has been facilitating Small Business Saturday since 2012 and this event has been a successful kick start to the holiday season. We collect promotions for Small Business Saturday and market shopping local all year long. We've even developed a Shop Laramie logo to help brand our 'shop local' messaging!

#### **PARKING DOWNTOWN**

#### **Education and Enhancments for Parking Downtown**


Downtown parking spots are precious commodities in small towns that rely on locally owned businesses as economy engines. Located centrally, and on both the north and south ends of the district, all day lots are perfect for downtown employees, visitors coming for events, and people who want to spend more than 2 hours shopping or dining. These lots provide 204 parking spots downtown.

In order to increase awareness of where the free, all day public parking lots are located downtown, Laramie Main Street Laramie is launching a Wyoming wildlife themed, "Name That Lot" campaign. Winning names will adorn new signs at each parking lot.

#### **FUTURE PROJECTS!**

New and exciting things are always in the works



#### **Downtown Housing**

The City of Laramie's 2015 housing study documented a need for 300 housing units downtown, consisting of 56 owner and 244 rental apartments, by 2030.

Members of our Economic Vitality Team and the Downtown Development Authority will work to inventory existing units and underutilized upper floors to create a plan to add new residential; bringing more people and expendable income into local businesses.



#### **3rd Street Updates**

Implementation of The "3,2,1...Third Street" Action Plan, a community-driven vision for improving the Third Street corridor, is scheduled for the summer of 2025! These improvements will enhance walkability, reduce congestion and accidents, and enhance the appearance.

#### **GIFT CERTIFICATE PROGRAM**

**Shopping local is made easy with downtown gift certificates - here's what you need to know** 

Downtown Laramie gift certificates work just like a check. Customers present you the gift certificate and you process the same as a personal check - they can pay remaining balances any way they choose or if they need change you can provide cash. You will deposit the gift certificate at your bank just like a personal check and get the full \$25 or \$10 value.

The public can purchase \$25 downtown gift certificates with cash or check at First Interstate Bank (221 E. Laramie Main Street provides \$10 versions of the gift certificates to volunteers or as giveaways. These work in the same way as the \$25 versions.

festival, participating downtown restaurants will infuse a menu item with flavors inspired by international community members and students .

#### JULY

Laramie's Brewfest hosts over 3,000 participants sampling beers, listening to live music and connecting with local vendors, while raising funds to ensure LMSA's services remain free to every business, building owner,

and entrepreneur in the downtown district. Funds are also allocated for downtown improvement projects, beautification, and public art.

#### **JUNE - SEPTEMBER**

The Laramie Farmers Market features over 60 vendors and organizations offering prepared food, fresh produce, artisan goods, activities and more; hosts weekly local musicians; and offers SNAP benefits, a nutrition assistance program provided by

the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Markets run every Friday during the summer at the depot parking lot downtown.
