
DOWNTOWN PARKING REPORT

Sage Grouse Lot 2nd & Custer 25 Parking Spots




Bison Lot 1st & University 20 Parking Spots

Reward business owners, employees, downtown residents, tourists, diners, and shoppers who choose to park in all-day lots with downtown gift certificates.



- Fifty \$10 downtown gift certificates were awarded to individuals who parked in the five newly named lots, for a total of \$500 in incentives.
- Of the fifty total gift certificate winners, downtown employees were rewarded most for parking in the all-day lots. Thank you to all the employees who are saving street parking for customers!
- Holiday lights were installed in the all-day parking lots to call attention to them and make them more inviting.
- Marketing efforts included social media posts, newsletters, and two press releases.
- The city created 22 extra diagonal spaces around N. 2nd St. between University Ave. & Clark St.
